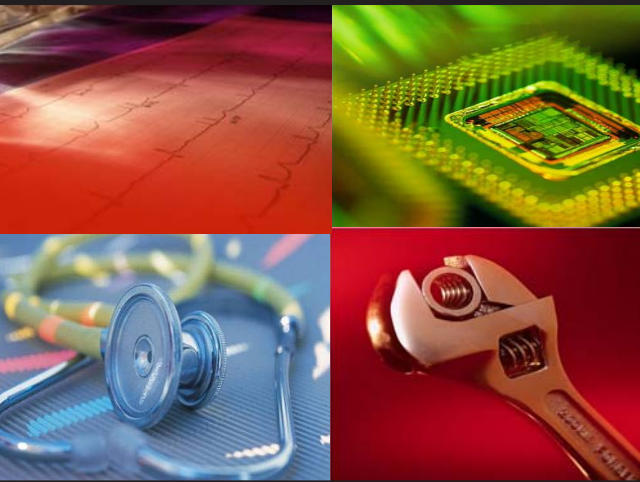

Course Information

The Academic Career Center (ACC) integrates support for math, reading, and communication skills with each students' career skills training. Students also learn job readiness skills and explore career possibilities.

TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education)—Tests levels of achievement in reading, math computation, math applications, and language.

Also available: Learning Styles Inventory by Educational Activities Software and Mock Interviews.

OKCIS (Oklahoma Career Information System) Electronic portfolios that include an on-line resume'. OKCIS also offers IDEAS Assessment, an on-line assessment to learn which occupations match student interests; SKILLS Assessment, to identify occupations that match student skills; O*Net Interest Profiler, to identify the importance of work values to the student; and O*Net Work Importance Locator, to help the student identify his/her strongest work related interests and explore occupations that meet those interests.
