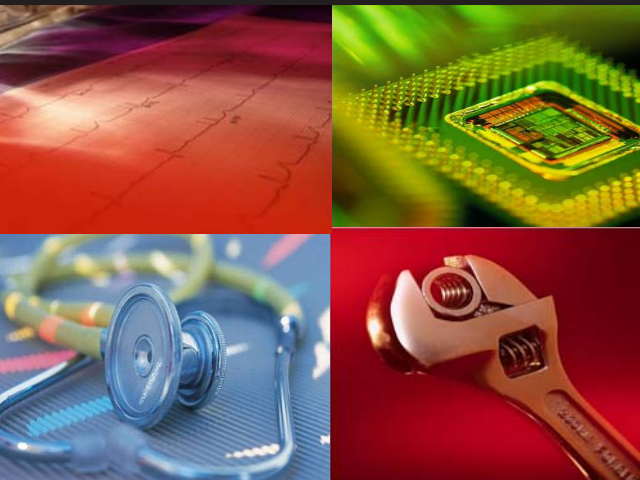

## Services Available

### Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available through the following programs: Workforce Investment Act, Federal Pell Grant, Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant Program, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Oklahoma National Guard Fee Waiver Program, Oklahoma G.I. Bill, and Veteran's Benefit. Certain criteria for eligibility must be met in order to receive assistance from these programs.

### Counseling

Counselors are available to assist prospective and current students with occupational choices, personal development, decision making, financial aid information, academic problems, and personal adjustment problems. Students needing support to help cope with any problem-emotional, marital, financial, alcoholic or chemical dependency-are encouraged to use counseling services.

### Assessment

All students will participate in a testing program that measures vocational interests, abilities, basic skill aptitudes, and work values. These tests will be administered at the beginning of the school year or when the student enrolls.

### Educational Enhancement Center

The Educational Enhancement Center (EEC) integrates support for math, reading, and communication skills with all students' vocational skills training. Students also learn job readiness skills and explore career possibilities.

Secondary students from Alva, Aline, Carmen, Chester, Cleo Springs, Canton, Dacoma, Fairview, Freedom, Ringwood and Waynoka may attend Northwest Technology Center free of charge. Recent graduates of these schools may also have the opportunity to attend tuition free if they meet the criteria for NWTC's "Next Step" scholarship. Adult or post secondary students who live in the NWTC school district pay in-district tuition. Those living outside the district pay an out of district rate for tuition.
